Diagnosis of signs of death according to Naadi reading (pulse); a literature study

Abstract

Siddha system has unique methods in diagnosis and prognosis of diseases and is mainly based on the methods "Envagaitherwegal". Among the Envagaithervugal Naudi is an important diagnostic and prognostic indicator and was explained by sage Therayar as well as eighteen Siddhars. Sage Therayar in his verse mentioned nandi only at the end of Envagaithervugal as it is used to confirm the diagnosis of disease and death. As this method is based on wisdom, the study aimed to conduct a literature survey on this method. Systemic review was done using the Siddha literature and research articles. The pulse assessment was done by feeling the naudi at wrist. If there is any imbalance in the normal proportion (I: 12: 1/4vatha, pitha, ayya respectively) of Uyirihathukkal it is reflected through neadi. For instance. Siddhars mentioned that death is sure when Avva nazdi independently doubles with the reduction or disapperance of vatham and nitham. It is futile to treat a rationt when his or her Vatha and Pitha pulse have disappeared. If the three naudis are combined and felt as one neadi simultaneously disannearing or the pulse felt like the fluttering of the cut tail of a streaked lizard, the signs show the neuring of death. The Naudi reading method is a convenient reliable and inexpensive method for diagnosis and prognosis of a disease which is gained by experience. Validation of this method may have impact on public health
